Komala's press relies

The Islamic Republic of Iran executed another Kurdish activist.

Mohammad Golabee as a Komla activist was executed in the city of Saghez.

According to the report which we received on March 2, 2003 at 4:00 AM stated that our comrade Mohammad Golabee was executed by hanging at the Saghez's prison.

Mohammad was from the "Kani Zerín" village bear the city of Saghez. He was a Komala Peshmargh(Kurdish for activist) for 4 years during the 1980's. He surrendered and went back to the city of Saghez to continue his civilian life.

After a while Mohammad returned to his political activities with the Komala organization. He was arrested in 1377 on the Iranian Calendar (which is 1998), and accused of being a activist for komala. For this reason he has been dtained in prison for the past 4 years, from the day of his arrest he was brutally interrogated and kept in a single person cell for 6 months. As a strong believer he never wanted to give up and as a result endured many cruel tortures. His unrelentless resistance, loyalty and trustworthiness were recognized ahd he soon became a public figure, and was well known throughout the city of Saghez. Mohammad was married with 2 children and as he was the only provider for his family, he made hand made art in prison in order to provide some income for his family.

After his execution they (executer the regime's guard)

didn't returned his body to his family. They took his body to the Ichi's cemetery near by Saghz as usual in order to prevent a formal funeral. At 7:00 AM the same day Mohammad's family, relatives friends and many other people attended a formal funeral service and relocated his body to the cemetery of their choice.

We the Komala Organization, extend our condolences to Mohammad's family, relatives and friends, as well as his comrades and the good people of the Saghez. The Komala also condemn this act of aggression. We would like to acknowledge the people of Kurdistan, Iran, and the international communities to be aware of the human rights violations against the Kurdish people in Iran. The Islamic Republic of Iran once again using the death of these political activists to set an example, for the public and to intimidate and strike fear into those who wish to follow. It is only a few days ago this barbaric regime executed Sasan Al kanan in the city of Sanandaj. He has been accused for the taking part in Komala's straggle.

The Komala would like the Kurdish, Iranian, political parties and independent human right activist as well as the international communities to condemn this these human violations,

and take action against them. You can put pressure on this Regime to stop this inhuman kind of act. We are hopeful in the futures this can be prevented by your effort. Komala organization hopes that this type of aggression will not intimidate the Kurdish people and their straggle, this regime can only isolate itself with this type of inhuman behavior.
